- *We will continue to use the All For Strings Book One by Robert Frost. (Please make sure you have the correct book for your instrument).
- *We will have two concerts. One in November and one in April.

- *Meets on Monday evenings from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m.
- *Auditions will be accepted from students ages 8 - 12 on violin, viola, cello & bass
- *Students must be proficient on the D, A & G strings with note reading experience.
- *If a student is not yet ready for this group, they may enjoy the option to be a member in our Level 1 or Level 2 classes.
- *We will have two concerts. One in November and one in April.

Junior Alternative Strings: Requirement: (Must have a minimum of 2 years of playing experience on the same instrument)

- *Meets on Monday evenings from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m.
- *Classes will involve instruction in fiddle styles including Bluegrass, Celtic, Old Time and more for violin, viola, cello and bass.
- *We will have two concerts. One in November and one in April.

Senior Alternative Strings: Requirement: (Must have completed one full year in Junior Alternative or receive recommendation by an SOS instructor)

- *Meets on Thursday evenings from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m.
- *Classes will involve instruction in Bluegrass, Jazz and Celtic for violin, viola, cello and bass.
- *Four concert opportunities. November, December, March (The Bluegrass Blowout) & April

Adult Novice String Orchestra Class:

- *Meets on the **2nd & 4th** Monday evenings of the month from 7:30 - 9:00 p.m.
- *Classes will involve instruction in a large group setting.
- *No audition required!
- *We will have two concerts. One in November and one in April

Tuition & Commitment:

String instruments are rewarding and can also be a challenge to play. Please understand that if you decide not to continue a class you have signed-up for, you will still be obligated to complete full payment for the class.
